### **Directions to Ben & Jerry's from Cabot Creamery in Cabot, VT:**

- Turn Left back onto Rte. 215 and follow back to Rte. 2
- Turn Right onto Rte. 2 West.
- Follow Rte. 2 West to Montpelier.
- Watch Signs for I-89 North.
- Follow I-89 North to Exit 10 (Waterbury/Stowe).
- Bear Right off Ramp onto Rte. 100.
- Follow Rte. 100 for approx. 1 mile. Ben & Jerry's will be on the left.
