(New England-style)

INNSEASON RESORTS JOINS THE RCI FAMILY

Whatever the season, it's always a great time to visit New England. The region is known for its miles of beaches, red-and-gold foliage and snowy winter activities.

RCI is proud to welcome InnSeason Resorts to its family of affiliated resorts. The seven properties—located in Massachusetts, New Hampshire and Maine—offer all the cozy comforts of a New England inn complemented by the services and amenities of a premier resort.

CAPE COD

As vacation destinations go, the town of Falmouth, MA, on southwestern Cape Cod, is first class. Visitors return year after year to experience its quaint shops, world-class seafood and maritime scenery, such as the view of Nobska Lighthouse in nearby Woods Hole (shown here). Boston, Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard are just quick day trips away.

All three of InnSeason's Cape Cod resorts are in Falmouth. **Captain's Quarters**, just across from the Falmouth Heights Beach, offers spacious one- and two-bedroom suites; the master bedrooms have whirlpool baths and fireplaces.

Guests at **HarborWalk** (see inset photos, left) stay in comfortable hotel-style rooms or renovated suites with kitchenettes. Close to the town center and the ferries to the islands, HarborWalk makes an ideal base for exploring the region.

Surfside, with the Atlantic on one side and Great Pond on the other, is the ultimate beach getaway. Accommodations range from studios to two-bedroom suites with decks and fully equipped efficiency kitchens. Guests can enjoy indoor and outdoor pools and tennis and bocce courts.

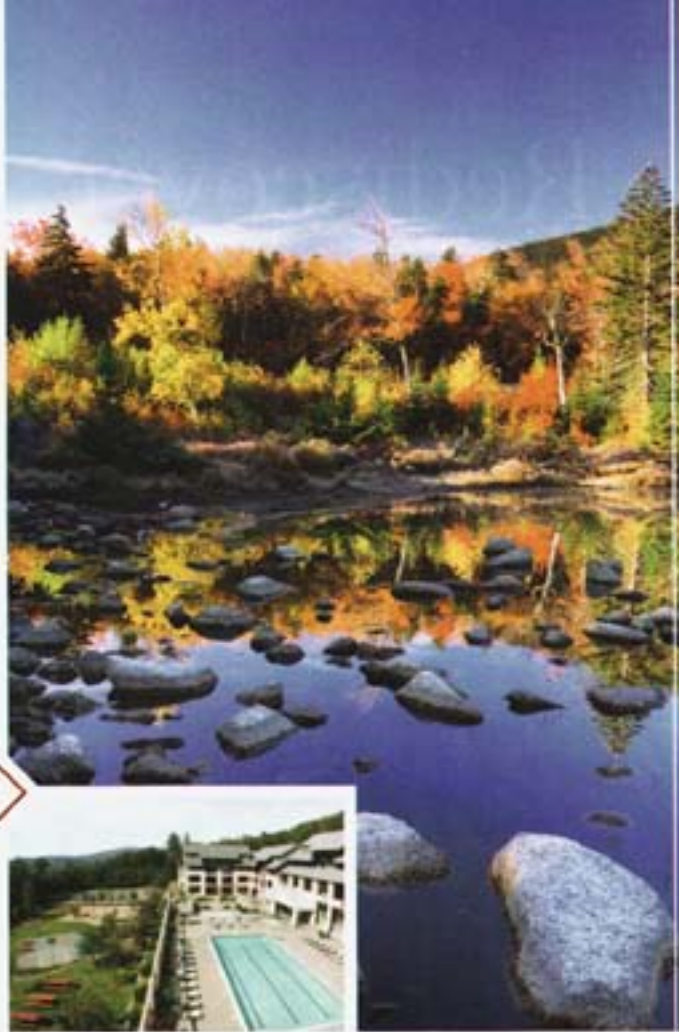


NEW HAMPSHIRE

The seasonal shows in the White Mountains—deep green summer forests, fiery fall colors, snow-covered peaks in winter and spring wildflowers—make for dramatic viewing. But New Hampshire's appeal is more than beautiful scenery. The state's two InnSeason resorts are both in Lincoln, a great place to find adventure or simply relax.

Pollard Brook (inset, right) lies across the valley from the Loon Mountain ski resort, by the 800,000-acre White Mountain National Forest. The 133-suite property has indoor and outdoor pools; during ski season, it runs a complimentary shuttle service to Loon.

Tucked at the base of Loon Mountain, **South Mountain** is perfect for romantic getaways and family vacations alike. It offers newly renovated hotel-style rooms and luxury condo suites with fireplaces and island kitchens. On-site amenities include spa services, a sauna, a library and a game room. The resort is right next to Lincoln Village Shops and close to summer theaters.



MAINE

The natural beauty of the Maine coast is matched by the unspoiled majesty of the state's forested interior. InnSeason Resorts brings you the best of both worlds, with properties in the seaside village of Ogunquit (right) and the pristine wilderness of Jackman, in northwestern Maine.

The Falls at Ogunquit (bottom, left) has 77 luxury suites, each with a living room, fireplace, separate bedroom and whirlpool bath. Guests can make use of the resort's indoor pool, exercise room and sauna. Among the activities offered are swimming classes for children and a barrier beach walk to discover coastal wildlife.

In Jackman, a four-hour drive north of Ogunquit, experience frontier life in luxury at the **Mountainview Resort** (bottom, right). Its 10 lodge suites and 10 spacious log cabins are situated on 40 wilderness acres. Each cabin has a fireplace and whirlpool bath; lodge suites have private decks. The resort's indoor and outdoor swimming pools, game room and pool table are available to all. In summer, guests can fish, hike and mountain bike; later in the year, there's skiing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling—and ice-fishing. ❄️
