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How to get there

Directions to Cabot Creamery from InnSeason Resorts Pollard Brook or South Mountain:
For those with GPS please enter in this address: 2878 Main Street, Cabot, VT 05647

- **Turn Right out of Pollard Brook Resort** or **Turn Left from South Mountain Resort.**
- Follow Main St. to I-93 North
- Follow I-93 North thru Littleton and into Vermont.
- Once in Vermont Bear Right onto I-91 North towards St. Johnsbury.
- Take Exit 21 and get on to Rte 2 West.
- Follow Rte. 2 West approx. 20 miles to Marshfield.
- In Marshfield turn Right onto Rte. 215.
- Follow Rte. 215 approx. 5 miles to the Cabot Creamery Visitors Center.
