

Train Rides



About this activity...

ON THE VALLEY TRAIN, you'll enjoy the scenery of the Mt. Washington Valley countryside and surrounding White Mountains as you travel roundtrip from the historic North Conway train station to either Conway or Bartlett, NH.

The 11-mile, 55-minute roundtrip Conway excursion is ideal for visitors wanting to experience the enjoyment of a "shorter" train ride. On this excursion, the "Valley Train" travels South past some of the area's farmlands, crossing Moat Brook and the Saco and Swift Rivers en route to Conway, where you can watch the powerful locomotive "run-around" the train in preparation for the return trip.

The 21 mile, 1 3/4 hour roundtrip Bartlett excursion offers you longer and more relaxing train rides. You're invited to sit back and enjoy the passing scenery and surrounding mountains, as the "Valley Train" travels northwest through fields and woodlands, crossing the East Branch, Saco, and Ellis Rivers en route to Bartlett. Upon arrival in Bartlett, you will also have the opportunity to watch the locomotive "run around" for the return trip to North Conway.

The Adventure Concierge recommends that you bring a camera and extra jacket or sweater. Remember, trains are fired by coal -- so dress accordingly. The temperature on top of Mount Washington can be 30 degrees colder than in Lincoln and it can snow any day of the year at the summit. This trip is ideal for families with young children, couples looking for a unique dining experience, or anyone looking to see life from the rails.

Travel time from Lincoln: 45-60 minutes. One way.

Plan time to explore the many unique stores of North Conway. There are some excellent restaurants within walking distance of the railroad.

How to get there

Directions to Conway Scenic Railway from InnSeason Resorts Pollard Brook or South Mountain:

- Turn Left out of Pollard Brook Resort Driveway OR Right from South Mountain Resort onto Kancamagus Highway (Rte. 112).
- Follow Rte. 112 approx. 35 miles to its end in North Conway. (Traffic Light)
- Turn Left at the Light onto Rte. 16 North.
- Follow Rte. 16 to the 2nd Traffic Light.
- Turn Left at 2nd Light and continue on Rte. 16 North.
- Follow Rte. 16 past all the Outlet Shopping.
- The Conway Scenic Railway is located in the Center of North Conway Village. It is located behind the town park on the left hand side of the road. There is ample parking in the surrounding area.
